



The Parking Services Department is pleased to announce the latest conversion to Multi Space Meters at the Amogerone parking lot (off Amogerone Crossway) Now, you don't have to worry about refilling your smartcard or scrambling to find a quarter!

You can pay with cash, coins, credit card and even with your SMARTPHONE! If you are paying at the Multi Space Meter, **record your license plate at the kiosk** and follow the step by step instructions on the screen or you can use the **Parkmobile** app found in the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android phones). Mobile users must sign up for the app and input **Zone 2475** for CVS, **Zone 2476** for Amogerone and **Zone 2477** for Post Office lot to pay for parking in that area. Please keep in mind there is a minimal convenience fee.



Parking Rules & Regulations

In effect **Monday through Saturday** from **9AM to 5PM**. There is no parking on Town property for more than 24 consecutive hours.

Zone 2475 (CVS)

- \$0.75/hour up to two (2) hours

Zone 2476 (Amogerone Parking Lot)

- \$0.50/hour up to twelve (12) hours

Zone 2477 (Post Office)

- \$0.75/hour up to two (2) hours
