Dear Ms. Stevenson:

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection ('the Department') acknowledges receipt of the notification dated January 31, 2017 (the "Notification") submitted by the Town of Darien. The Notification was submitted pursuant to Section 5. (d) of the MTS GP and Part 1 (1) of the Appendix to the MTS GP. The Notification informs the Department that Town of Darien will begin collecting for recycling smoke detectors. Smoke detectors are authorized for receipt and collection at the transfer station as well as transfer from the facility, through Registration No. 03501158-MTSGP under the MTS GP which was issued on July 1, 2014. The storage area for smoke detectors should be monitored by facility staff and in a secure building.

Within sixty (60) days of this acknowledgement please submit to the Department updated professional engineer certified as-builts drawings depicting any changes to the facility that result from the collection and storage of the additional authorized solid waste. The collection and storage of smoke detectors shall be conducted in compliance with the terms and conditions of the MTS GP.
